Welcome to our inaugural college-wide commencement ceremony, marking the close of a historic Summer 2023 Residency, as all six of VCFA's MFA Programs — Film, Graphic Design, Music Composition, Visual Art, Writing, and Writing for Children & Young Adults — gathered together for the first time on the campus of Colorado College.

Vermont College of Fine Arts is a place where the creative expression of individuals is nurtured and a sense of community flourishes. Our student-centered, low-residency educational model is driven by individualized teaching, learning, and advising.

Our six degree-granting programs have, since their inception, operated independently, and while this decentralized approach has had many strengths, it has also presented meaningful challenges that have prevented the college from being as nimble and responsive to the changing demographics and needs of our students, as higher education costs rise, and the demands on faculty and staff increase.

Artists have always been at the forefront of provoking new thinking, innovating new models, and inspiring change. It is in that spirit of those groundbreaking leaps of faith that we come together as six programs that share a commitment to innovation, individualized learning, and community.

While the location of our physical residencies has changed, the spirit of VCFA has not. Brilliance, inspiration, synergies, and excellence continue to form the heart of the VCFA experience.

Naomi Shihab Nye Summer 2023 Honorary Degree Recipient

Naomi Shihab Nye was born to a Palestinian father and an American mother and grew up in St. Louis, Jerusalem, and San Antonio. Drawing on her Palestinian-American heritage, the cultural diversity of her home in Texas, and her experiences traveling in Asia, Europe, Canada, Mexico, and the Middle East, Nye uses her writing to attest to our shared humanity.

Nye is the author of numerous books of poems, most recently *Cast Away: Poems for Our Time* (Greenwillow Books, 2020). Her other books of poetry include *The Tiny Journalist* (BOA Editions, 2019); *Voices in the Air: Poems for Listeners* (Greenwillow Books, 2018); *Transfer* (BOA Editions, 2011); *You and Yours* (BOA Editions, 2005), which received the Isabella Gardner Poetry Award; and *19 Varieties of Gazelle: Poems of the Middle East* (Greenwillow Books, 2002), a collection of new and selected poems about the Middle East.

She is also the author of many books of poetry and fiction for children, including *Habibi* (Simon Pulse, 1997), for which she received the Jane Addams Children's Book Award in 1998. Nye's additional honors include awards from the International Poetry Forum and the Texas Institute of Letters, the Carity Randall Prize, the National Book Critics Circle Lifetime Achievement Award, and four Pushcart Prizes. She has been a Lannan Fellow, a Guggenheim Fellow, and a Witter Bynner Fellow. In 1988, she received the Academy of American Poets' Lavan Award, judged by W.S. Merwin.
